


Arriving by tram: Exit Mozartkreuzung

## Impressions

How much greenery does a city need? Where are the most interesting places in Linz? What stories are there to tell about the urban parks? With a relatively high proportion of green Linz offers a variety of areas with a wide range of activities: You can meet for sports or chat, during the lunch break, the park bench offers space for a snack and maybe even a nap. Some are looking for loneliness, others for society and some are living there as well: urban oasis and habitat, social meeting place and sanctuary, playground and resting place.

Linz is a growing city. In the last 15 years, the urban population has increased by more than 10%. The urban space lies in the area of tension between expansion and compression. It is all the more important to secure freedom for future generations. At the same time, we are in the Anthropocene, a new geological epoch formed by the effects of human action that brings about climatic changes. It is important to deal with these challenges.

The exhibition explores the traces of the Linz open spaces and focusses historical facts, picturesque views, current trends and visions of the future of the gardens, squares and parks of Linz. In addition to large and historic places such as the Volksgarten, smaller and less well-known places are also brought into focus.



• Guided herbal tour in the floodplain of the south of Linz

The Traun-Donau-Auen

The largest part of the Traun-Donau-Auen is legally protected as a nature reserve. This unique natural space should remain protected and still be available to the inhabitants of the solarCity for a nature experience. For walks, nature trails were newly created in the Natura 2000 area of the Traun-Donau-Auen. These sign-posted hiking trails gently open up parts of the Au area for the visitors on the basis of a visitor guidance concept. The Traun-Danube floodplains provide ideal habitats for numerous rare animal and plant species. The diverse vegetation of the Natura 2000 protected area is characterized by gray-alder, willow and hardwood meadows. In this habitat are also beaver, kingfisher, oriole, grebe, bats, grass snakes and tree frogs.

• Permacultural forest – guided tour in Wels (entrance fee, guided tour)

Österreichisches Waldgarten-Institut is situated at the countryside of Wels, the 8th biggest town of Austria. Our Forest garden or edible Foodforest was started in 1992 by Hans Hermann Gruber, based on the principles of Permaculture, specialy influenced by the ideas of Robert Hard. Our total land contains 3 ha: our more than 25 years old forest garden on 4.500 m2, an Walnut-Agroforest on 4.000 m2, madows, ochards, forest and a new established forest garden with Chinampas (600 m2 watersurface) on 5.700 m2.

We do have a segmented chickrun with Chicken heated Greenhous, Greenhouse, Wormfarm, Solardryer, fireplace where we do terra preta, shiitake farm, log roundhouse with mandala roof, ...

We are teaching people in permaculture since 2007, in 2009 we were conducting the first training for transition in german language in Austria, we are getting students and visitiors from all over the world, we are also working together with smallscale farmers in developing countries. We are also in the WWooFing Programm.
