Getting to Marseille from Marseille Provence Airport



SHUTTLE: e recommend you to take the shuttle 'la navette', which runs between the Aéroport de Marseille Provence and the city centre (Gare Marseille Saint-Charles). During the day it arrives every 15 to 20 minutes. The journey takes approximately 25 minutes. You can buy your ticket in advance online, from the ticket office in the airport, or from the bus driver, if the ticket office is closed. Tickets cost 8.30€. The shuttle runs from 05:30 - 21:30 and departs from the bus station outside the airport, at quai 6 (platform 6).

The train station is centrally located. Not far from Eurocircle, you can easily get there by foot or by metro to all the proposed and other accommodations.

TAXI: Taxis from Marseille Provence airport to Marseille city centre cost around 50€ during the day, and 60€ at night. Taxi station phone: 00.33.4.91.02.20.20 https://www.taximarseille.com/

TRAIN: Rumor has it that you can also take trains into the city. We do not recommend trying it.

Get fed in Marseille

Not exactly "typically French", the city still has a lot to offer in terms of cuisine. There is hardly a restaurant that we cannot recommend.

However, if your French is not fluent and you have allergies or a special diet, it is better to go with an escort or to selected places where they know how to speak English.

While you're here you should definetly have some Pizza from a truck and/or CousCous, too, to get your Marseille experience right (unless you're on a special diet).


For breakfast, just go to the nearest boulangerie and point to a pain au chocolat or croissant. Nothing can go wrong.
